The Richland Fire & Emergency Services (RF&ES) Scholarship was established to help RF&ES firefighters achieve their academic and career goals. These men and women have a significant impact on our community and deserve recognition for their integrity and unwavering dedication to duty.

#### **Eligibility Requirements**

The applicant must be a RF&ES firefighter:

- In good standing with the department.
- Enrolled in a degree program (undergraduate through post-graduate) at an accredited college or university, full or part-time.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better on a 4.0 scale.
- Have completed the department's probationary period.

#### **Caveats**

- Three \$2,000 scholarships will be awarded.
- Recipients have one year to request funds to enroll at the educational institution they attend.
- This scholarship is not available to members or relatives of the RF&ES Scholarship Selection Committee or employees or families of the Three Rivers Community Foundation.
